Thank you for inquiring about our sliding-scale shares. Through the help of our shareholders and other donors, we are happy to be able to provide some assistance to help people participate as shareholders of our farm.

2008 Shareholder Application

If you are interested in becoming a shareholder you must fill out the Shareholder Application as well as the Sliding-Scale Share application.

Share Cost

The cost of a 2008 CSA share is \$475 (\$525 for Portland Delivery). We distribute food over approximately 19 weeks of the season. If you average this out, the cost is about \$25 per week.

Share Size

We estimate that the amount of food in a share will be ample for a family of four, depending upon how you eat. Some people decide to split a share if they think that it will be too much food for them. Feel free to contact the farm with any questions that you may have about the size of the share. There is also a lot of good information on our website that can help you figure out whether to split your share with someone.

Payment Plans

We are very open to payment plans of all types. After we figure out how much assistance we are able to provide we will talk with you about setting up a payment plan to help spread out the remaining payments.

Timeline/Decision Process

We hope to be able to get back to you within two weeks of receiving your application with an answer of what, if any, funding we are able to provide. Please check in if you do not hear from us.
